**Situation**  
Concise description of the issues that need to be addressed, include whether the situation needs to be increased, decreased, lessened etc.

Milwaukee downtown voices positioned us as a Global Water City, but community had not weighed-in. We want community informed vision of what it means to truly be a model water city.

**Causes - "Sanitized"**

- Lack of value for community input
- No pathways for community engagement
  - Distrust of community
- Siloing
- Segregation
- Collusion of government and market

**Causes - "Un-sanitized"**

- Patriarchy
- Structural Racism
- Capitalism
